The Aethos Sound Meditation is a sonic piece that was created by Tom to access the non-dual states of consciousness characteristic of 10th dimensional Hathors. The simplest way to listen to the Aethos is to focus your attention on the sound patterns. When your mind wanders, bring it back to the sounds.

While the Aethos is generally a calming experience for most people, it is definitely a transformational sonic creation. Thus, it is suggested that you listen to the five-minute version (track 1) first, until you get used to it.

After you are comfortable with the five-minute form of the sound meditation, you can move on to the thirty-minute version (track 2) if you wish.

Tracks 3,4, 5 & 6 were recorded live at *The Art of Seeding New Realities*, a Hathor Intensive (Nov 4-6 2012) in Seattle, Washington. During these four sound pieces, using the Aethos sound meditation

as the background, Tom channeled vocal tones from the higher dimensional realms of the Hathors. These tones can be quite mindaltering and transformative. Listening to them with your attention in the corresponding chakra (in the title of each track) will impart greater potency and transformation.

Do not listen to this recording in situations requiring alertness, such as driving a car.
